- 11. **Update on the Examination in Public of the Core Strategy:** Cllr Ingham reported that to date the EiP was progressing well. The Parish Council's objection to the high number of proposed new dwellings in the village compared to lower percentages in other towns and parishes had been acknowledged by the Inspector. So too had concerns about housing densities on the Donkey Field should the Parish Council's preference for protection of the site from all development be overturned. The Inspector had not shown sympathy for refusing development on the site, but had asked CDC to consider adding wording to Policy CS 6, "Strategic Housing Allocations" to provide for any development on the Donkey Field to take account of the character of the surrounding roads. Cllr Ingham was hopeful that the opportunity would arise for him to have some input into that wording. Cllr Ingham was authorised to engage in such discussions and agree the necessary wording.

In conclusion, Cllr Drew thanked Cllr Ingham for his valuable input to the EiP and the work he had undertaken in preparation.

- **12. Any Other Business:** The Clerk was asked to appoint a volunteer from members of the committee to take a lead in discussions about the shortly expected planning application from Buckinghamshire County Council for the waste transfer station at the London Road depot (Amersham dump).
