If a call is received from the Press comments can only be made once the plans have been examined.
 - (ii) E-mail from WPFC The Assistant Clerk summarised an e-mail from Mr McGuinn of WPFC who are one of the biggest users of Westwood Park. They would like to meet with a member of the Council on a Saturday morning to discuss the Club and the possible siting of a storage container at the park. Cllrs Drew and Hinkly agreed to meet with Mr McGuinn. The Assistant Clerk will set up the meeting.
