- 7. To review response from Mr G Winwright on New Developments in Little Chalfont Maintenance of Lights and Open Space: It was agreed that the 17 September response from Mr Winwright indicated that the Parish Council is under no obligation to accept any responsibility for the lighting and open space maintenance in the Turners Field development and that the Management Company set up by the developers has an ongoing responsibility for this. Cllr Phillips offered to speak to Mr Winwright, and report back to the Parish Council, about what our responsibility might be for this site, and for any other new sites such as the Donkey Field in the longer term, after any management company's responsibility ends.
- 8. **Chiltern District Council DDPD**. (i) It was noted that that two new SHLAA sites have been added in Little Chalfont. These are No. 542 Elizabeth Avenue including the shops and the land behind, and, No 543 Citygate and the adjacent carpark /garage area combined. (ii) It was agreed that The Parish Council would write to Mr Winwright to request confirmation / clarification about the designation of the Citygate site and the adjacent car park. Specifically, we wish to ensure that any reference to this location as a SHLAA site should specify that the potential housing and commercial development must include adequate public parking to replace the now derelict parking site.
- 9. **Decisions of Chiltern District Council's Planning Committee**: An updated schedule had been circulated previously.

- 13. Any other business: It was noted that the following applications had been called in to be discussed at the 31 October meeting of CDC's Planning Committee: (i) CH/2013/1245/FA Site 101 (Known as The Donkey Field), Burtons Lane, Little Chalfont -It was agreed that the Parish Council would send along a representative to object to this application; (ii) CH/2013/1488/FA Holm Oak, Cokes Lane, Little Chalfont, HP8 4UD; (iii) Chalfont St Peter draft Neighbourhood Plan - the draft neighbourhood plan for Chalfont St Peter is available to be viewed on the website cspplan.org.uk. It was agreed to discuss any implications of this draft and the approach being followed at a future Planning Committee meeting.

Note: it is suggested that the Planning Committee have a brief discussion at the next Planning meeting because the previously suggested date of 3 December would be after the closing date of 29 November for comments on the Plan.
