## Minutes of a Meeting of Little Chalfont Parish Council Planning Committee Held in the Village Hall, Cokes Lane, Little Chalfont Wednesday 8 May 2013 at 7.30pm

- 1. Apologies for absence: These were received from Cllr L Hunt and Cllr J Walford, OBE.
- 2. **Approval of the minutes of the Planning Committee meeting held on Tuesday 16 April 2013**: These were approved as a correct record and were signed as such by the Chairman.
- 3. **Proposal to suspend standing orders enabling members of the public to speak**: The proposal was agreed. Speaking in his capacity as both a Chenies Parade trader and a director of the Chenies Parade Management Company, Mr T Robertson objected to planning application CH/2013/0372/FA, Land between Chenies Parade and Garage. Whilst acknowledging that the site under consideration had been an eyesore for too long, he and fellow directors disagreed strongly with comments made by the applicant in the Transport Statement about parking. Facts and figures quoted were inaccurate. Parking on the parade is very difficult and the areas to the side and rear, referred to by the applicant, are in fact privately owned for use by Chenies Parade businesses, staff and residents living in the flats. Parking provision proposed in the application was inadequate and would place a great burden on the existing but already inadequate public parking. He also suggested that the applicants should liaise with any future Donkey Field developers on the possibility of widening the relief road to help address the serious parking problems at Chenies Parade. Thanking Mr Robertson for his comments, the Chairman reinstated standing orders.
