It does not accept the argument that the existing substantial and historic farmhouse would become an ancillary building and see the application as a means of developing a second habitable dwelling on this site in the Green Belt and AONB. Such an inappropriate development would be contrary to NPPF and CDC Policies. As indicated in the objection posted by site, neighbours, the development would also suggest an unrequested change of use, and degradation of the agricultural site, and it would have an adverse impact on the village's wildlife and cultural heritage.

Compared with previously rejected application CH/2016/1091/FA, the change made to the plans are minor and do not address the cramped, contrived, obtrusive and discordant form issues which were the principal reasons for the previous application's rejection.

CH/2016/1805/FA Croft Farm, Burtons Lane, Little Chalfont, HP8 4BA	Increase roof ridge height to create two storey dwelling and single storey rear extension	Although in principle the changes made to the approved application CH/2014/1695/FA are in themselves objectionable, the Parish Council continues to object to this overdevelopment of the site which is on the Green Belt and in AONB.
CH/2016/1809/FA Rosemount, Burtons Lane, Little Chalfont, HP8 4BN	Two storey side extension, first floor rear extension and conversion of garage to habitable accommodation (amendment to permission CH/2016/0785/FA)	No Objection
CH/2016/1854/FA Rowood Farm, Burtons Lane, Little Chalfont, HP8 4BA	Demolition of existing farm buildings, removal of hard standing an erection of two detached dwellings.	The Parish Council objects. It considers that approval of the application CH/2014/0396/FA was at the limit of an acceptable development on the Green Belt and that the now proposed two dwelling development would constitute inappropriate development of the site. If CDC disregards this recommendation and grants approval, the Parish Council requests that such approval is conditional on appropriate action to control the danger of the shared access issue to/from Burtons Lane

		where the speed limit is 60 mph. The issue already exists but would be exacerbated if there was additional traffic from another residence.
