

Buckinghamshire Local Plan – Site Engagement Consultation (Closes 16 March 2026)

Buckinghamshire Council is currently running the Site Engagement stage of the Buckinghamshire Local Plan consultation.

This stage follows the Draft Local Plan consultation in October 2025, which the Parish Council highlighted on this website last year.

The current consultation focuses on sites that have been submitted to Buckinghamshire Council for possible development as part of the future Local Plan. An interactive map is available showing the locations of submitted sites across Buckinghamshire, including those in and around Little Chalfont.

Although the sites are colour-coded on the map, residents should note that all submitted sites are under consideration and could potentially be developed, subject to further assessment through the Local Plan process.

Residents who wish to comment can review the information and submit their views directly to Buckinghamshire Council via the consultation portal:

When responding, residents should consider the wider impact on the community, rather than just their only individual circumstances. Emphasis on the latter can mean that the comment will not be considered.

Comments can address:

- The suitability of specific sites
- The infrastructure that would be required to support development (such as roads, schools, healthcare, drainage, and utilities)
- The type of housing that may be needed locally, both now and over the next 20 years, to support the future needs of the community

All responses should be submitted directly to Buckinghamshire Council through the consultation website.
